This is a FORWARD of one of the several emails sent to, in particular, Councilor Vince Brennan, a Progressive Party member currently the incumbent in Ward 3. He did not REPLY or reply in any way to this or to several other emails, nor did Emma Mulvaney Stanak. I suppose partially because I am a political opponent, but mostly because he has no clue as to the reality of this situation or how to handle it, Vince Brennan refuses to have anything to do with it.

AdChoices

I am an Independent Candidate for Ward 3 Councilor March 5th, but that is not the reason I am raising this issue. I have felt for a long time that the mindset of the Burlington City Council is opposed to grappling with real problems.

Miroslav Zbacnik (his usual spelling) came here in the wave of refugees from the Yugoslav civil war. He was in the Croatian Army, he likes to say in "Special Forces" [as a captain] but in reality he was in what Nazi Germany called Einsatzgruppen, or, extermination squads. He was tossed out because of his brutality--according to him he, possibly along with others, murdered numerous Serbians and Bosnians (Bosnians, he explains, are regarded in Yugoslavia, as "niggers" are in the United States,) including, in one instance, some 30 grade school students of kindergarten and first grade age and their teacher. The Burlington City Council held a meeting about two weeks ago at which the main topic of discussion and the public forum was a proposal to set up a City-wide ban on "assault weapons". This is as a result of the now infamous Newtown massacre, in Connecticut.

Since the fall of 2011 I have sought the deportation of Mr. Zbacnik. I challenged Vince Brennan at the Channel 17 televised candidates' debate several nights ago to explain why he never replied to any of my emails or would speak to me at the council meetings, which I frequently attend. He delivered basically a non-sequitar to my challenge, except at the end to say, well, a complaint (a numbered ICE deportation complaint, on which ICE has taken no action whatsoever), has been filed, ~~he, as a city councilor, has no authority over federal matters~~, and so on, yet he and nine other members of the city council of Burlington Vermont feel they have the right to pass a municipal ordinance that supersedes both state of Vermont and United States federal law. This is a bit of a contradiction.

Mr. Zbacnik has developed a long criminal record since emigrating to the United States, including numerous arrests for DUI, including felony DUI, and choking a ten year old boy who displeased him, wrecking an apartment, numerous domestic assault complaints and the like. In the delivered copy of this email I attach a portion of his rap sheet, available at the Costello Courthouse.

Mr. Brennan could have visited the slum landlord who owns 72 Murray Street #4, where Mr Zbacnik lived illegally with a Heidi Johnson for some amount of time, a couple of years at least. This address is directly across from the Barnes School, the Sustainability Academy, where Mr. Brennan was a school board member. The children in the playground of the Barnes School used to line up at the fence around the playground to watch Mr. Zbacnik in any of his many fist fights with neighbors and people who would stop by with whom he had quarreled, which is quite a few people. Mr. Zbacnik could easily have been

trespassed off the property by the landlord since he was living there illegally. Mr. Brennan would not do this.

Mr Zbacnik and Ms. Johnson have since moved. The drug addict [David Wagner] who lived in the room above their apartment started a fire smoking in bed while on drugs and the fire companies which responded essentially destroyed the interiors of the apartments hosing them down, destroying those sections the fire had not yet reached. Ms. Johnson, as a Section 8 recipient was given a new apartment somewhere in Williston. Mr. Zbacnik tried to tag along, but he had another of his disputes with her, this one brought on by his not getting on the SSI rolls, which she had been counting on for spending money. Mr. Zbacnik over the years lived off the welfare received by a number of women, Ms. Heidi Johnson being only the latest. She has a long psychiatric history and a history of having children removed by DCF, apparently especially because of the presence of Mr. Zbacnik.

The property is, of course, a slum dwelling rented by a slum landlord exclusively to Section 8 recipients. He made no effort to check on who lived there. Mr. Miroslav Zbacnik lived there, having participated in the murder of 30 Serbian schoolchildren, and here, in the U.S. , having attacked a ten year old boy, for which he went to prison. This seems to be of no concern to Mr. Brennan, who was given a complete copy of Mr. Zbacnik's rap sheet.

Mr. Zbacnik now no longer resides with Ms. Johnson, he collects bottles, participates in petty crime, and stays drunk as much as he can, living in an apartment on George Street.

It would be a simple matter for this council to have the city attorney and police chief use the office of the governor and of the attorney general to contact the governments of Croatia, Serbia, and Bosnia, for a list of war criminals who have not been detained, and for war crimes unsolved. The slaughter of 30 schoolchildren in their classroom and their teacher would have been a landmark war crime. Maybe he went in masked and was not identified. Maybe his Croatian Army war records are in Cyrillic instead of the Roman alphabet. But the crime can be identified and he freely talks about his participation in it around Burlington. This council has access to the BPD chief of police, to a former police chief who is now Vermont's safety director or some such, to the attorney general's office. Councilor Kranichfeld is a state's attorney. It is ridiculously easy for the city council to take action to retrieve a warrant on Mr. Zbacnik and present it to an inactive homeland security/ICE office, and to the FBI, for action. This council pretends to have great concern for the possibility of mass murders in Burlington VT, while a mass murderer from Yugoslavia freely walks around the streets of this city. He has spoken and bragged about this matter and the murders he has committed to many people. I believe the VT National Guard has deployed to Bosnia. This past year and a half have been constant medical crises for myself, namely laser eye surgery, blocked veins being treated by warfarin and a constantly inflamed small bowel. I have at times been in a lot of pain simply trying to walk. Being homeless has not helped since a great deal of time is spent simply in survival mode. Your resolution and vote to ban firearms puts you in the position that you have a moral obligation to deal with the problem of a war criminal who committed a schoolroom slaughter even worse than that in Newtown CT. Mr. Brennan feels not, even though the war criminal lived feet from the school at which he was a school board member. I accuse Mr. Brennan of being a total hypocrite. He has not denied the reality of my accusation against Mr. Zbacnik. Perhaps because I am not a member of the Progressive Party, nothing will be done on his part about this matter.

I would like a response (REPLY) from each member of the Burlington City Council and from Mayor Weinberger. Mayor Weinberger has attended meetings with other mayors to foster gun control. How about control of the perpetrators

of massacres, Mayor Weinberger?

I have recordings of threats by Mr. Zbacnik calling my cell phone. He warns me of "big trouble", possibly because of my very existence. There are ethnic Serbians in this area who want Mr. Zbacnik dead. I merely want him deported to stand trial for capital murder. This Mayor and Council thinks much of what it thinks is a highly moral stance on the use and possession of firearms. Is it moral to allow Mr. Zbacnik to wander around Burlington as he pleases? His present poverty and constant intoxication are pretty much the only checks on his ability to do harm, and perhaps anonymity. He should never have begun threatening me and bragging about murdering 30 schoolchildren, and so he will no longer remain anonymous.

On his criminal record he is listed as being a US citizen, but I do not know if he ever actually obtained citizenship. The information on the rap sheet, is, of course, derived from Mr. Zbacnik.

Copies of this email are being distributed to various PTAs and school boards of the schools in Burlington Vermont.

Subject: A Croatian war criminal who did ethnic cleansing resides on Murray Street.

Vince and Emma:

At 72 Murray Street #4 there is an apt rented to a Heidi Johnson, a 37 year old woman with a very long psychiatric history. I have not yet checked on her criminal record, if any. The apt is in her name. Her sometime consort is Miroslav ("Mike") Zbacnik, apparently dishonorably discharged from the Croatian armed forces in the mid to late 1990s for raping and murdering non-Croatians, principally Bosnians and Serbians. On June 30, 2011 I began ICE complaint 02293804 to have MZ deported. He often has fistfights with people in his, or, rather, Heidi Johnson's yard, hosts drug dealers like Dennis Savo as his guests and so on. His criminal record includes a conviction for battery on Heidi, who, frankly, is over 300 pounds, about 5-7 or so and has few possibilities. The State of VT has already seized one or more of her children for neglect and abuse.

MZ drinks continuously. He has 3 convictions for DUI, including the last a felony. He has a conviction for choking a ten year old boy. He is not on the sex registry list.

MZ often has flashbacks, including talking about and reliving a particular ethnic cleansing operation in which he and possibly others killed about 30 schoolchildren of first grade age and their teacher, Serbians I believe, with automatic weapons. He obviously falsified his immigration application. He is aware of my ICE complaint. I have tape-recorded threats from him, left on my voicemail. I am attempting to get his Croatian army record and NATO occupation force information on this operation I have just described.

He is a very heavy drinker and coughs up blood at night, apparently from ulcers, he has had a collapsed lung and other ailments, all of it undoubtedly tied in to his drinking. He has flashbacks and believes at times he is still fighting Serbs and Bosnians. There is more that I really don't want to describe right now, but basically the slum landlords in the intersection of Murray and North Streets only care about the money the govt gives them via subsidy programs. He is an illegal tenant, and I am going to city hall this week to see who owns 72 Murray Street, which is also 153-155 North Street.

Do either or both of you care to join me in talking to the landlord to have him trespass off the property? ICE is apparently doing little, possibly as a result of the current administration's policy of reviewing deportations on a case by case basis. ICE will not disclose anything it is doing or not doing.

Information there is a one-way street. He is apparently considering marrying Heidi Johnson as a legal ploy to delay or stop deportation, if ICE gets around to doing that or taking him to court in Boston. I will leave his VT criminal record in your home mailboxes.

What are the odds this jerk will do something lethal, with schoolchildren watching his antics, crowding the fence at times. I have observed this. I know for a fact he has tried to obtain a handgun to defend himself from the Serbs in town who want him dead for killing relatives of theirs. The BPD hassled him for possessing a pellet gun, for example.

Daniel Savo, brother to Dennis Savo, was arrested some 8-9 months ago when he fled into the FS with a drawn handgun after, I am told, committing two stickups of convenience stores. The Savo family is a bunch of violent hard core rednecks. They don't like me, have participated in slashing an occasional tire on my vehicle. Dennis Savo obviously could get him a gun. MZ apparently does not get any kind of welfare, SSI or even FS. There is a reason for this that has to do with his part ownership of property back in Croatia, it would seem. He lives off welfare women, taking their checks, that sort of thing. I am not particularly afraid of him, but in my own mind this guy has just got to go. He beats up women regularly, he has never carried thru on his threats against me. I frankly hoped when he was in the hospital months ago he would die with the collapsed lung, but fate gave him another chance.

I will give, as I said, both of you a copy of the main points of his police and conviction record here in VT. If I can dig up a warrant from Croatia or Serbia, maybe I can goose ICE into actually doing something.

He depends on Heidi Johnson for room and board. Otherwise he collects some bottles in shopping carts. He has been fired from every regular job he has held. Collection agencies have given up on collecting from him. He heavily damaged a Chase Street apt, apparently while he was in the process of beating up his former wife, a Jasminka, who divorced him and kept the three children, who are now all young adults. I have no contact with her and I am not sure she would talk to me and I have not researched her current address.

I became involved with his case under odd circumstances that I don't want to describe right now. Perhaps his marriage plans mean ICE has sent him a letter of some sort, but they have not picked him up although they have the 72 Murray Street address (I made sure of that.) I am going to inform the staff of the sustainability academy and their PTA about this. He needs an out-ing very badly. As I said, what are the odds. I know for a fact he wants weapons, the police are always stopping him. When he is "wanted" Heidi hides him in her shower. She has poor prospects for romance, to be honest, and she has settled for him, even though he attacked and beat her when they were living in a tent. I do not know if he ever carried thru and obtained citizenship.

Wait until I leave the paperwork for you to REPLY. This is independent of any other matter.





Now comes Officer Laura Pezzulo, affiant, being duly sworn and on oath deposes and says she has probable cause to believe that Miroslav Zbacnik (11-28-66) has committed the crime of Simple Assault, in violation of Title 13 V.S.A. 1023 (a) (1).

1. On May 16, 2004 at approximately 2200 hours, I was assigned to the front desk at the Burlington Police Department. On this date and time, Nada Tabakovic (04-15-75) came into the lobby with her ten year old son, A.T. Nada advised her son was assaulted by a family friend.
2. She stated her family was over at 85 Manhattan visiting a friend of the family's, Miroslav Zbacnik (11-28-66), the defendant. At some point during the evening, the defendant noticed shaving cream on the bathroom mirror. He suspected A.T., the victim, did it. The victim stated the defendant took him by the hand and brought him into the bathroom and then shut the door. In his written statement, the victim said the defendant "stardid (sic) to chok (sic) me". The defendant placed his hand on the back of the victim's neck and started yelling at him. The victim stated he was very scared and had trouble breathing. When asked if the difficulty breathing was due to him being scared or due to the defendant's hand around the back of his neck, he advised it was because he was scared. The victim did feel pain when it occurred. I did not observe any bruising, swelling, or redness around the neck. The nine year old daughter of Nada opened the bathroom door when she heard the victim screaming. She saw the defendant's hand around the victim's neck. The victim's mother and father stated they also heard the victim screaming and ran to the bathroom. They did not see the defendant's hand on the victim's neck. Toward the end of my interview, the mother stated she was going to bring the victim to the emergency room for his neck.
3. The next day, the defendant willingly came into the police department front lobby for an interview. He stated that when he saw the bathroom mirror, he asked the victim to come into the bathroom. The defendant denied shutting the door. He was asking the victim why he did that. The victim began laughing. That was when he put his hand on his neck to get his attention. He admitted he placed his hand around the victim's neck, but stated he used "little" force. He stated he in no way could have hurt him and that he never would intend to do so. He added that the victim never screamed nor did he appear scared.

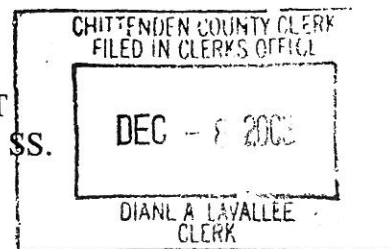

**AFFIDAVIT OF ANN MILIZIA IN SUPPORT
OF MOTION FOR DEFAULT JUDGMENT**

I, Ann Milizia, at Burlington, Vermont, depose and say under oath as follows:

1. That I am over the age of 18 and believe in the obligations of an oath.
2. That I am a property manager and agent for the Plaintiff, Investment Property

Managers, Inc. As part of my job function I track and monitor rental properties on behalf of the Plaintiff, and serve as the point of contact for tenants who may have issues concerning their rental units. The Plaintiff maintains files on all tenants, which contain the application, credit report, payment history logs, and any complaints made by or against the tenant.

3. One of the rental units properties and operated by the Plaintiff is the building at 79 Chase Street, Unit B, Burlington, Vermont, which is the premises at issue in this eviction case.

4. By virtue of my position, I have reviewed and am familiar with the tenant file of the Defendants, Misoslav and Jasminka Zbacnik..

5. The Defendants monthly rental payment is \$850.00, due on the first of each month, with a portion to be contributed by the Vermont Housing Authority's (VHA) Section 8 Voucher Program. The Defendants are jointly and severally responsible for a monthly contribution of \$335.00. The Defendants fell behind in their contribution to the monthly rental payment and as of the date the Complaint in this case was filed were in arrears in the amount of \$1599.09.

JUDGMENT ORDER


The above-entitled matter came on for consideration on _____, 2003,

Judgment. On the basis of the evidence presented, is it hereby ADJUDGED:

1. Judgment is awarded Plaintiff against the Defendants Miroslav and Jasminka Zbacnik, jointly and severally, in the amount of \$335.00 in back rent, plus \$297.34 in cleaning fees beyond ordinary wear and tear, \$456.20 in repair fees, \$90.00 in fees incurred by the Plaintiff in having the locks on the premises re-keyed, attorney's fees and costs of \$390.00, court costs of \$150.00, sheriff's service fees of \$91.64, less \$853.66 for the security deposit and interest withheld by the Plaintiff, for a total judgment amount of \$956.52.
2. Interest shall accrue at the rate of 12% per annum on the judgment less any pre-judgment interest.
3. The Defendants having previously vacated the premises, a writ of possession is unnecessary.

6. On or about November 12, 2003, the Defendants vacated the premises but failed to turn in their keys as requested, necessitating the re-keying of the locks on the premises. In addition, the premises were found to be in a sub-par condition and needed a good deal of work before other tenants could move in. The required repairs consisted of the replacement of a bedroom door and the sheetrocking of a large hole in the ceiling (labor and materials). Also, significant cleaning was required as to virtually every surface and appliance.


