RE: FY 13 – Budget Amendments to use balance of funds in revenue account

The **Burlington POLICE Department** respectfully requests approval to utilize funds received putting on the RAD class to cover the expenditures through 6/30/2013 for the RAD Program.

The goal is to have the RAD Program be self supported with revenue from the class fee.

In FY 13, we received \$875 through RAD classes held over the past year. The monies were deposited to **101-17-050.4600_105**. Expenditures for RAD in the past have been channeled through the Training budget. In the new accounting system, the **Training Materials account**, **101-17-050.6700_107** and **Travel & Training – Special Training 6700_105**, are best suited to handle the expenses associated with the class, as detailed on the attached expense list to be incurred before 6/30/2013 and year end.

Attached is a copy of the request to expend the remaining RAD monies received this fiscal.
