The Skinny Pancake is requesting to expand our capacity from our current capacity when we expand the physical size of our space.

Our current capacity is 63 ppl in 1200 sq ft or, when the tables & chairs are removed, 83 ppl. Consistent with multiple capacities for a variety of configurations, we have supplied the City with three layouts that all detail different capacities. With an expanded space of 2775 sq ft, our architect has suggested fire code compliant capacities of 161 seats on up to a standing room capacity of 233 ppl. Both of these capacities account for up to 12 staff and 8 people in the performance areas. Of course, both are subject to final Fire Marshal approval.
