## Burlington Redistricting Committee Report to City Council June 8, 2013

The redistricting committee met fives times in April, May and early June of 2013. The committee developed criteria for assessing plans, and discussed and refined a number of options using BTV Votes software.

At the its June 4 meeting, the committee voted to refer the following three plans to the City Council for its consideration (listed in no particular order) with the Committee's vote:

- ➤ 8 Wards, 16 Councilors: committee vote of 6-6 with 2 abstaining
- 4 Wards, 12 Councilors: committee vote of 9-5
- ➤ 6 Wards, 13 Councilors: committee vote of 8-5
