- 3) Planning Commission Create clear definitions of "Domestic Animals" and "Livestock" and rules that address each category appropriately, including the recommendations from the Board of Health with regards to appropriate shelter and care requirements, with a report back to the Council by April 29, 2013.
- 4) Planning Commission Revise zoning ordinance to address definitions of agricultural structures and propose appropriate regulations as recommended in section 5.5 of the Task Force report. The use of driveways for agricultural purposes should be considered as well. The Commission shall report back to the Council by April 29, 2013; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Council recognizes the extensive public engagement process and detailed research that are summarized in the Task Force report, and as such recommends giving considerable weight to the recommendations contained therein. However, given the nature of the task at hand, the Council does not recommend adhering strictly to the recommendations of the Task Force in every particular. Practices and regulations of other Cities, as well as creating a practical, supportive framework for urban agriculture should be considered in making recommendations for changing our ordinance.
