## ADDITIONAL ARCHITECTURAL OR STRUCTURAL DESCRIPTION:

2½-story, four-square plan house with first story clapboard, second story shingle, box cornice, fascia trim, corner and sill boards. Center hip roof dormer with 2/2 sash windows. Front hip roof porch with chamfered posts, box cornice, square railing and trellis skirt. Half pane and half panel door. Large 2/2 sash window with frosted panes outlining upper sash. 2/2 sash windows with lip molds on facade. Rear shed addition. Front center chimney.

RELATED STRUCTURES: (Describe)


Single bay, clapboard, asphalt hip roof garage: Double hinge doors with 8 lights over raised panels, on a cement foundation (12' x 14') c.1925.

## STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE:

This well-preserved four-square house was built for a University of Vermont professor. Both the house and the garage are the only unaltered examples of this style on Latham Court, which was developed during 1920-40 to accommodate a need for housing in east Burlington.
