While supporters argue that the deployment of the F-35 is inevitable and Burlington might as well be the place to reap the touted job benefits, this is shoddy ethical reasoning by any standard, and masks the actual consequences of acquiescence: namely, selling a few thousand low-income residents' neighborhood for the price of at most a few hundred jobs, with no guarantees for local hiring, living wages, job security, etc. More fundamentally, a vote for submitting to the F-35 siting is a vote against the idea that municipal politics is a viable site of resistance to the unproductive (in terms of real human needs) behemoth of the security-industrial complex. Boondoggle "weapons systems" like the F-35 are only the most crystalline example of the US war economy's wasteful and destructive raison d'être: the enrichment of war profiteers at the expense of livable environment in communities worldwide. Since the irrational logic of this system is a necessary component of a broader monopolistic economy that relies on financialization, public plunder and the proliferation of useless toxic junk from Waffle-O-Matics to F-35s, there is little prospect of challenging this logic at the national level at present. This is perhaps one reason why so many of us in a place like Burlington choose to be involved in municipal politics: at the level of human-scale democracy where decisions affecting our neighbors are actually in our hands, we have the chance to make a powerful statement in favor of our neighbors in the "uninhabitable zone" — and also in favor of Burlington values, the values of a different kind of world.
