15 Resolved by the City Council of the City of Burlington, as follows:

17 That WHEREAS, the General Manager of the Burlington Electric Department has recommended  
18 creation of an Energy Efficiency Program & Policy Analyst position due to the increased demands of the  
19 Smart Grid Project, and requirements of State and Federal Regulatory Agencies including the Department  
20 of Energy, Federal Electric Regulatory Commission; and

21 WHEREAS, the Human Resources Director has used the Modified Winters Classification Plan to  
22 determine a recommended pay scale for this position; and

23 WHEREAS, this request has been approved by the Human Resources Director and Finance Board;

25 WHEREAS, this position will be funded through the revenues generated by the Burlington  
26 Electric Department specifically designated for energy efficiency programs as prescribed by State statute;

27 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the creation of a classified, regular, full-time  
28 Energy Efficiency Program & Policy Analyst position for the Burlington Electric Department is approved  
29 and shall be placed at a Union Salary Grade A04 within the Burlington Electric Salary Table. The  
30 position shall be created upon date of City Council approval and signature of the Mayor.
