ACTIONIZATION FOR BOREINGTON TELECOM TO SEEK RELIEF FROM CONDITION 60 OF ITS CERTIFICATE OF PUBLIC GOOD

That WHEREAS, by Resolution dated August 11, 2008, the City Council authorized Burlington Telecom (õBTö) to proceed before the Vermont Public Service Board (õPSBö) to amend Condition 17 of its CPG to reflect the City Counciløs policy of funding the remaining build out of the system as revenues allow; and

WHEREAS, during the pendency of the PSB proceeding it became apparent that the City also needs temporary relief from Condition 60 of its CPG, which requires BT to reimburse the Cityøs pooled cash management system within two months of the Cityøs expenditure of such funds on behalf of BT; and

WHEREAS, BTøs state-of-the-art, fiber-to-the-home telecommunications system has the capacity to serve approximately 100,000 customers, a capacity which far exceeds the number of customers in Burlington; and

WHEREAS, BT needs to expand its services outside the corporate boundaries of the City of Burlington to produce revenues that will allow it to complete the build out of the remaining sections within the City;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that Burlington Telecom be and hereby is authorized to amend its petition presently pending before the PSB to also seek temporary relief from Condition 60; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Council confirms its authorization for BT to

negotiate with other towns as provided by Resolution dated Oct. 22, 2007 and BT is instructed to

seek out opportunities to expand its services outside the City of Burlington, with the

understanding that further City Council approval is required prior to pursuing any opportunities

outside the City.
