14 In the year Two Thousand Ten.....

15 Resolved by the City Council of the City of Burlington, as follows:

16  
17 That WHEREAS, the City Council Charter Change Committee hereby recommends that the following  
18 question be placed on the 2010 Annual City Meeting ballot;

19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the following question be placed on the ballot of  
20 the Annual City Meeting to be held March 2, 2010:

21 “Shall the Charter of the City of Burlington, Acts of 1949, No. 298 as amended be further  
22 amended to amend Sections 154 thereof to read as follows:

23 Sec. 154. Composition.

24 The board of finance shall be constituted as follows: The mayor shall, ex officio, be chairman of said  
25 board and together with the president of the city council, ~~the chief administrative officer~~, and ~~two~~ three  
26 additional members of the city council who shall be elected at the first meeting of the city council in April  
27 of each year and who shall serve a term of one year from the date of their election shall constitute said  
28 board of finance. ~~Each of the additional two members elected from the city council shall be members of~~  
29 ~~different political parties.~~ All of the three additional members elected from the city council may not be  
30 members of the same political party. The members of said board shall be trustees of public moneys for  
31 the city and shall have the power and perform all the duties of similar officers in towns of this state;  
32 provided, however, that they shall make no investment or reinvestment of any of the cemetery endowment  
33 funds of the city without first obtaining the written approval thereof by a majority of the board of  
34 cemetery commissioners. In the absence or disability of the mayor or president of the city council the  
35 chief administrative officer shall sit as a member.”
