WHEREAS, the mission of VEH is to help our state and citizens through the promotion
of economic health and affordability in Vermont and fiscal discipline in Montpelier; and

WHEREAS, nearly 1,000 Vermonters have signed VEH’s online petition calling for a
long-term economic plan; and

WHEREAS, VEH provides economic analysis and has provided the legislature with
policy papers as well as having been invited to give testimony to the House Ways and Means
Committee during the 2010 Legislative session; and

WHEREAS, over two dozen “town meeting forums” have been presented throughout the
state, from as far south as Manchester and Bennington to as far north as St. Albans; and

WHEREAS, this council recognizes the importance of economic health, affordability and
the need for our community to be open to all perspectives, ideas and ways to improve our
economy, and

WHEREAS, VEH would like to host a town meeting forum in Burlington in Contois
Auditorium and would encourage everyone in the community to attend;
