Resolved by the City Council of the City of Burlington, as follows:

That WHEREAS, the governing body of the City of Burlington, Vermont ("Lessee") desires to lease purchase certain equipment (the "Equipment") described in Equipment Schedule A to the Master Lease Agreement (collectively, the "Lease Purchase Agreement") with TD Equipment Finance, Inc. of Portland, Maine, the form of which has been available for review by the governing body of Lessee prior to this meeting; and,

WHEREAS, the Equipment is essential for the Lessee to perform its governmental functions; and

WHEREAS, the funds made available under the Lease Purchase Agreement will reimburse the Burlington International Airport for expenditures to acquire essential equipment in fiscal year 2010; and

WHEREAS, Lessee has taken the necessary steps, including those relating to any applicable legal bidding requirements, to arrange for the acquisition of the Equipment; and

WHEREAS, Lessee proposes to enter into a Ten Year Lease Purchase Agreement for

WHEREAS, the Finance Board reviewed the bids for this lease purchase financing and approved and accepted the low bid submitted by TD Equipment Finance, Inc. at its meeting on May 17, 2010 and recommends approval of the same by the City Council;

attached term sheet are hereby approved. The Chief Administrative Officer of Lessee and any

other officer of Lessee who shall have power to execute contracts on behalf of Lessee be, and

each of them hereby is, authorized to execute, acknowledge and deliver the required Lease

Purchase Agreement, subject to prior review and approval of the City Attorney, such approval to

be conclusively evidenced by such execution and delivery of the Lease Purchase Agreement.

The Chief Administrative Officer of the Lessee and any other officer of Lessee who shall have

power to do so be, and each of them hereby is, authorized to affix the official seal of Lessee to

the Lease Purchase Agreement and attest the same.

Section 3. The proper officers of Lessee be, and each of them hereby is, authorized and directed

to execute and deliver any and all papers, instruments, opinions, certificates, affidavits and other

documents and to do or cause to be done any and all other acts and things necessary or proper for

carrying out this resolution.
