15 Resolved by the City Council of the City of Burlington, as follows:  
16

17 That WHEREAS, Primary, General, and Annual City elections are occurring on August 24,  
18 2010, November 2, 2010, and March 1, 2011 respectively; and

19 WHEREAS, one of the elected Ward Three Inspectors of Election resigned on  
20 August 13, 2010 prior to the August 24, 2010 primary election and there is now also a vacancy  
21 for one of the Ward Five Inspectors of Election; and

22 WHEREAS, the City Council did not meet between the date of the Ward Three  
23 inspector's resignation and the primary election and Mayor Kiss and Ward Three Councilor  
24 Mulvaney-Stanak asked Charles Giannoni to serve as Ward Three Inspector of Election for the  
25 primary on August 24, 2010 and he did so; and

26 WHEREAS, these vacancies in the elected Inspectors of Election positions must be filled  
27 by the City Council pursuant to City Charter § 13; and

28 WHEREAS, Charles Giannoni, Democrat, of 63 Rose Street has served as an assistant  
29 election official previously and is willing and able to serve as Ward Three Inspector of Election  
30 for the term ending March 31, 2013; and

31 WHEREAS, Abigail Russell, Progressive, of 288 Flynn Ave. #5 has served as an  
32 assistant election official previously and is willing and able to serve as Ward Five Inspector of  
33 Election for the term ending March 31, 2012;

38 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Burlington City Council approves and  
39 ratifies the appointment of Charles Giannoni, Democrat, of 63 Rose St. as Ward Three Inspector  
40 of Election, effective August 24, 2010 with said appointment to stay in effect through March 31,  
41 2013; and

42 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Burlington City Council approves the  
43 appointment of Abigail Russell, Progressive, of 288 Flynn Ave. #5 as Ward Five Inspector of  
44 Election, effective immediately with said appointment to stay in effect through March 31, 2012.
