16 17	That WHEREAS, the Burlington City Council has adopted new ordinances to provide civil
18	redress for nuisance behaviors (disorderly conduct, unlawful mischief and unlawful trespass)
19	which have traditionally been addressed by the criminal justice system; and
20	WHEREAS, there is an ongoing public discussion concerning public safety and quality
21	of life issues as presenting in Burlington's downtown; and
22	WHEREAS, particular attention has recently focused on the chronic nature of certain
23	violations of the law (disorderly conduct and public alcohol consumption in particular) in the
24	downtown generally and in City Hall Park specifically; and
25	WHEREAS, there is a sense of public frustration with the fact that traditional methods of
26	addressing these violations of the law have not deterred the incidents of such violations and
27	numerous individuals appear to chronically commit these violations; and
28	WHEREAS, the City has already created civil ordinances (Disorderly Conduct, Unlawful
29	Mischief and Unlawful Trespass) as alternatives to traditional criminal prosecution of some low-
30	level violations of the law; and
31	WHEREAS, the City is now adopting a City Hall Park Ordinance as a pilot program (as
32	described in a communication from Police Chief Schirling to City Council attached hereto and
33	incorporated herein) with the hope that the provisions contained therein, including trespass

40	welcoming environment for and by the public; and

42	concerns in a manner that is both fair and just;
43	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that as a part of this pilot program, a report
44	from the Burlington Police Department and the City Attorney's Office shall be submitted to the
45	City Council on or before the first City Council meeting in the month of July, 2011, updating
46	City Council on the status of the program, whereupon the City Council shall conduct a review of
47	the program after receipt of the report for purposes of examining whether the ordinance needs to
48	be modified, terminated or continued on as is.
