## RESOLUTION Resolution Relating to Sponsor(2): Ouncilors Hartnett, 1 Adrian, Dober 06/06/11 2 Introduced: 3 Referred to: 4 5 Action: 6 COUNCIL INVOLVEMENT IN DEPARTMENT HEAD HIRES 7 8 Signed by Mayor: 9 10 CITY OF BURLINGTON 11 12 13 In the year Two Thousand Eleven..... 14 Resolved by the City Council of the City of Burlington, as follows: 15 16 That WHEREAS, during the recent hiring process for the City of Burlington's Director 17 of Aviation a wide array of individuals were invited by the Mayor to participate in interviewing 18 candidates and recommending finalists; and 19 20 WHEREAS, despite the Mayor's extensive effort at outreach, no City Councilor was invited to 21 participate in interviewing applicants or recommending finalists; and 22 23 WHEREAS, the lack of a Council representative meant that no City Councilor had first-hand 24 knowledge of what transpired during the hiring process, or was able to make any truly 25 independent assessments of the strengths or weaknesses of candidates or how precise a fit the 26 candidates might be with the City, Burlington International Airport, and the position of Director 27 of Aviation itself, all of which a rigorous hiring process is meant to address; and 28 29 WHEREAS, once a candidate was selected for hire and introduced to the City Council, the entire 30 Council was effectively being told why the candidate should be hired rather than being asked if 31 the candidate should be hired; and 32 33 WHEREAS, while the Council respects that it is the Mayor's power and decision to appoint a 34 35 Director of Aviation and other Department Heads as set forth in Section 122 of the City Charter, that same section also states that those appointments "...shall require the approval of a majority 36 of the whole number of the city council"; and 37 38 WHEREAS, the Council's power and decision in the reappointment of Department Heads may 39 only be ceremonial, but its power and decision in the initial appointment of a Department Head 40 is binding, and this is a responsibility which the Council takes very seriously; and 41 42 WHEREAS, in the recent hiring process for the Director of Aviation, it would have been very 43 helpful to the Council if a Councilor had been involved with interviewing candidates and 44 recommending finalists because that Councilor could have easily kept the Council regularly 45 briefed on the process and its results, that Councilor could have been sure Council concerns were 46 addressed earlier rather than later, that Councilor would have provided the Council with a sense 47 of participation and ownership of the ultimate recommendation, and that Councilor might even 48 have been helpful to the Mayor by sharing with him a Council perspective as the process
